We will be learning:

In science, we will be sorting and testing materials to find out which is the most suitable for different purposes.

In DT we will be learning about mechanisms, wheels and axles.

In Computing we will be learning about Online Safety. We will be thinking about how we can keep ourselves safe when online.

In History we will be learning about key events linked to space travel.

In R.E we will be learning about the nativity story and what this teaches Christians about Jesus.

In P.E we will be exploring different ways of moving and travelling.

In Music we will be starting to learn some Christmas songs!

We will also be beginning this half term with Stay Safe Week. We will be learning about road safety, fire safety and online safety.

Key English skills for your child:

- Recognising and blending with all phase 5 graphemes.
- Starting each sentence with a capital letter and ending it with a full stop.
- Understanding the difference between a statement and a question.
- Writing clearly with correct letter formation with the writing sitting on the lines.
- When reading, answering questions about what has happened and why.

Key Maths skills for your child:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to 50 or 100
- Partitioning a two digit number into tens and ones
- Adding or subtracting single-digit numbers
- adding a two-digit number and ones, or a two-digit number and tens
- Knowing number bonds to 10, and then number bonds to 20
