Science: we will be learning about materials and experimenting with their properties.

Key Maths skills for your child:

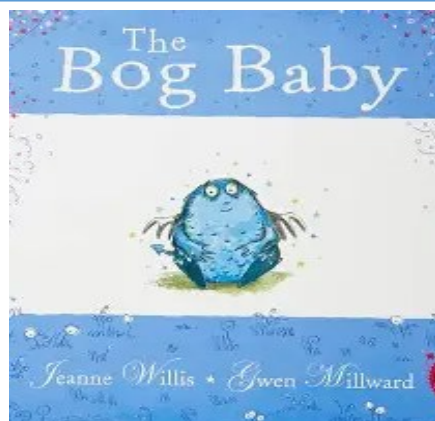
This half term we will be focusing on addition and subtraction, including;

- Adding and subtracting one digit and two digit numbers.
- Adding and subtracting across a ten.
- Knowing number bonds to 100.

Year 2 Overview – Autumn 2

Our core story is:

The Bog Baby by Jeanne Willis Please do not read this at home with your child until the end of the half term so your child can enjoy hearing the story unfold in class.



At home you could:

- Read daily at home and talk about what you have read, including reading a range of fiction, non fiction and poetry.
- Practice addition and subtraction fact families to 10, 20 and 100.
- Practice counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s.
- Talk about online safety at home and your own family rules for using devices.
- Make your own stable structures using junk modelling resources.

Key English skills for your child:

- Reading with increasing accuracy and fluency.
- Answering questions and making links about what they have read.
- Writing clearly with correct letter formation and with the writing sitting on the lines.
- Leaving clear finger spaces between words and using correct punctuation.
- Reading and spelling common exception words.
- Using interesting word choices when writing including adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions and similes.
