I wish you all a safe, restful and enjoyable summer break.

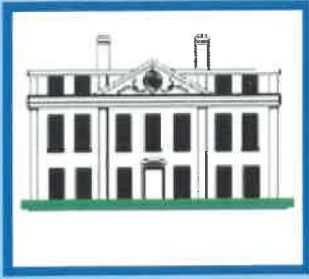

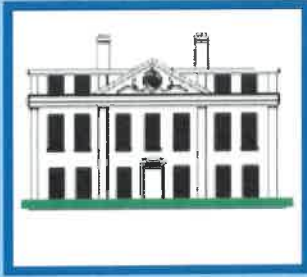

We are so grateful to Sue and Holly in our kitchen for all their hard work again this year.



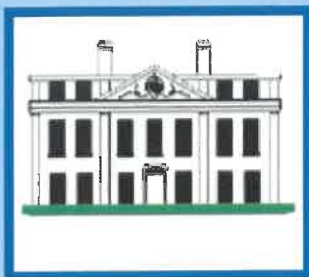

This enables us to record your child's attendance correctly. If we do not receive completed forms, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

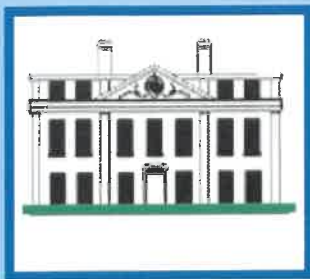

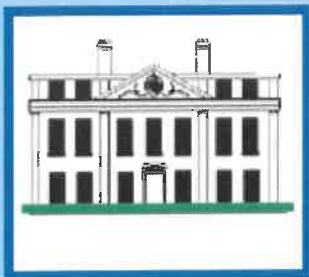
